Assistive technology is any item or equipment used to increase, maintain or improve functional capabilities of individuals with disabilities.

Developmental delays are often exhibited in children with disabilities because of limited opportunity for interaction. Assistive technology benefits children who need specialized equipment or alternative means of engaging in communication, mobility or play.

- **Adaptive mobility equipment** such as crutches, walkers, and wheelchairs to assist with walking.

- **Adapted computers and software** for children with visual or physical impairments.
- **Adapted bathrooms or feeding equipment** for children who need assistance in daily cares.
- **Switches** to operate toys, lights and appliances for children who cannot access their environment.
